- 3 The replies will not attempt or purport to deal with matters which relate to functions of district councils, the Dept of Environment for NI or other public bodies or with charges registered in the Statutory Charges Register or matters registered in the Land Registry or Registry of Deeds.
- 4 The replies are based on present proposals and these may change.
- 5 The replies are furnished in accordance with the information at present available to officers of the NIHE and on the understanding that neither the NIHE nor any officer of the NIHE is legally responsible therefor.
- 6 It is the policy of the Executive in relation to any answer regarding proposals for redevelopment to refer only to "proposed redevelopment areas" declared by the Executive pursuant of Article 47 of the Housing (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.
